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**Public Water Supply District #2 of St. Charles County, Missouri  
LSLSIP – Inspection and Access Structures Contract Award**

April 18, 2016 – At the Water District’s April 13<sup>th</sup> Board meeting, the Board of Directors approved contracts with Interactive Pipe Inspection (IPI) for inspection, location, and condition assessment of the existing sanitary sewer mains located underneath Lake St. Louis and Lake St. Louise. In addition to the inspection, location, and condition assessment of the mains, five new access structures are to be constructed within the lakes to enhance future access to the sanitary sewer system.

Work is expected to commence immediately, with field work expected to be complete by October 31, 2016. Prior to any work being performed on an individual’s private property, IPI will be directly contacting affected residents to ensure that they are informed on what type and duration of activity that can be expected during this project.

This work is being performed as part of the Water District’s Lake St. Louis Sewer Improvement Program, which is a proactive effort to evaluate and potentially upgrade or replace the sewers that currently run underneath both Lakes St. Louis and St. Louise.
