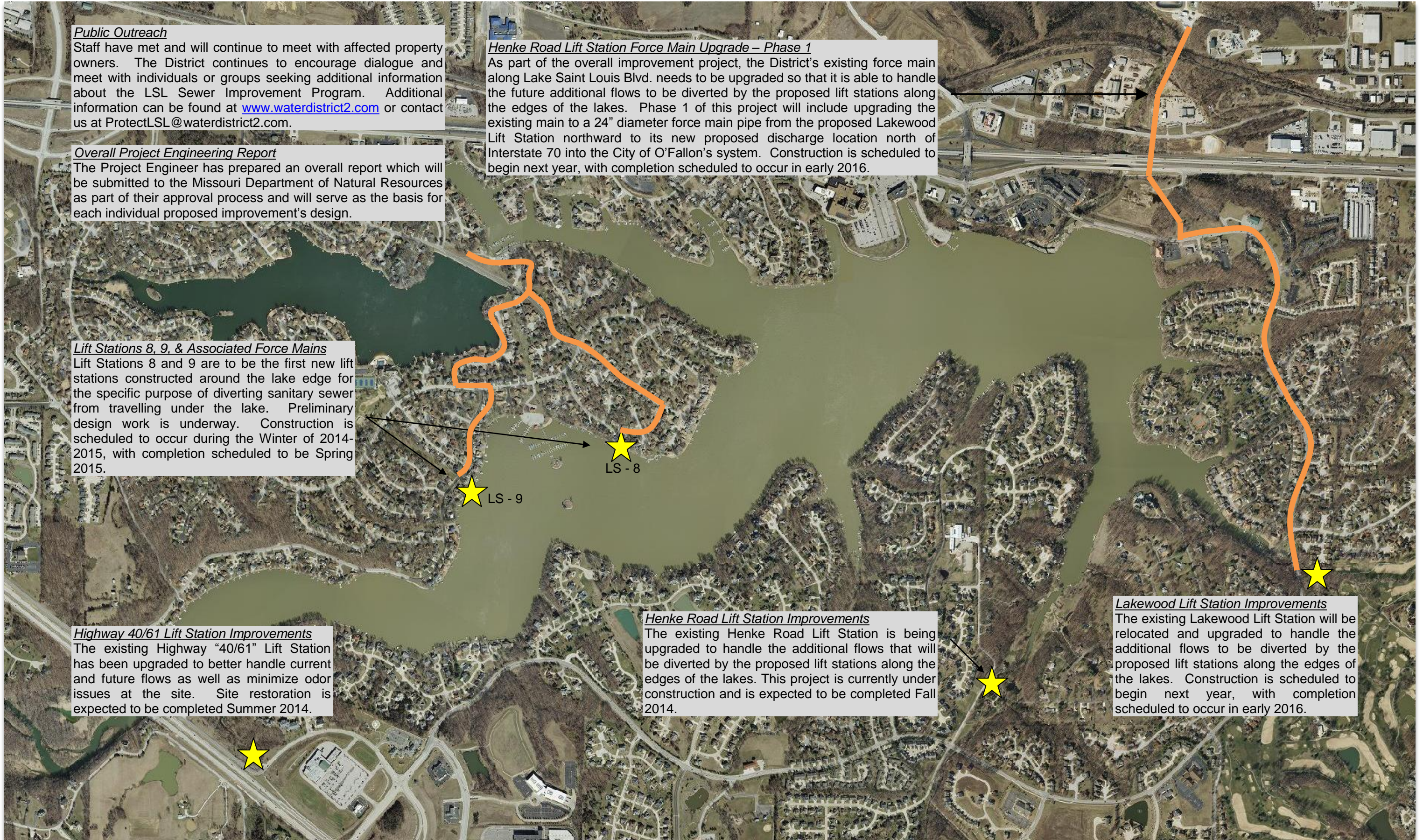

Overall Project Engineering Report

The Project Engineer has prepared an overall report which will be submitted to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources as part of their approval process and will serve as the basis for each individual proposed improvement's design.

Henke Road Lift Station Force Main Upgrade – Phase 1

As part of the overall improvement project, the District's existing force main along Lake Saint Louis Blvd. needs to be upgraded so that it is able to handle the future additional flows to be diverted by the proposed lift stations along the edges of the lakes. Phase 1 of this project will include upgrading the existing main to a 24" diameter force main pipe from the proposed Lakewood Lift Station northward to its new proposed discharge location north of Interstate 70 into the City of O'Fallon's system. Construction is scheduled to begin next year, with completion scheduled to occur in early 2016.

Lift Stations 8, 9, & Associated Force Mains

Lift Stations 8 and 9 are to be the first new lift stations constructed around the lake edge for the specific purpose of diverting sanitary sewer from travelling under the lake. Preliminary design work is underway. Construction is scheduled to occur during the Winter of 2014-2015, with completion scheduled to be Spring 2015.

Highway 40/61 Lift Station Improvements

The existing Highway "40/61" Lift Station has been upgraded to better handle current and future flows as well as minimize odor issues at the site. Site restoration is expected to be completed Summer 2014.

Henke Road Lift Station Improvements

The existing Henke Road Lift Station is being upgraded to handle the additional flows that will be diverted by the proposed lift stations along the edges of the lakes. This project is currently under construction and is expected to be completed Fall 2014.

Lakewood Lift Station Improvements

The existing Lakewood Lift Station will be relocated and upgraded to handle the additional flows to be diverted by the proposed lift stations along the edges of the lakes. Construction is scheduled to begin next year, with completion scheduled to occur in early 2016.
