LAKWOOD LIFT STATION IMPROVEMENTS
SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The work to be performed generally consists of the following:

Construction of a triplex submersible wastewater pumping station with a firm capacity of 950 GPM, and associated infrastructure as required to replace existing package pump station and approximately 1,030 feet of 8-inch to 12-inch diameter sanitary sewer at location in the City of Lake St. Louis, Missouri. The successful bidder will be responsible for furnishing, constructing and installing all structures, equipment, site improvements, materials, labor and ancillary work necessary to provide complete and functional facilities in accordance with the requirements of the contract documents.

Bidders must submit qualification information as described in Section 00200, Instructions to Bidders.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at the offices of the Owner on September 14, 2017 at 9:00 A.M. Attendance of this meeting by prospective bidders is recommended, but not mandatory.

Bidding Documents may be obtained from the office of the Owner at a non-refundable charge of **\$100.00** per set by cash or certified check.

A bid security in the amount of five (5) percent of the Bidder’s maximum Bid Price is required.

Prospective bidders are hereby advised of requirements for jobsite safety and worker eligibility contained in Section 00800 (Supplementary Conditions) of the contract documents.

Wages shall be paid to each employee engaged in the Work at a rate not less than the prevailing rate of wages for the particular trade or occupation, as issued by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations of the State of Missouri. The Contractor shall be responsible for complying with the prevailing rate of wages for St. Charles County, Missouri for all work conducted within St. Charles County.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive all informalities not involving price, time or changes in the Work, and to negotiate contract terms with the Successful Bidder.
